

'OUT OF UNIFORM DAY' GUIDELINES

At Xavier, wearing appropriate clothing for casual clothes days displays a sense of pride in ourselves and in our community. It is expected that students follow the guidelines below and maintain a high standard of personal grooming and neatness.

- No thongs
- No revealing clothing (Appropriately covered cleavage, shoulders and midriffs)
- Appropriate length shorts / skirts (No shorter than 10cm above the knee)
- No offensive images or words on clothing
- Shoulders to be covered
- No underwear on display
- No tattered clothes
- Clothes are appropriate to weather conditions

Students who attend school or an excursion wearing inappropriate clothing will be given an everyday uniform from the clothing pool to wear for the day.

ACCEPTABLE ACCESSORIES

- Earrings: one pair of small, plain, gold or silver sleepers or studs to be worn in the lobe of each ear.
- Bracelets: one simple bracelet only.
- Neck chain: single plain chain
- Watch
- Ring: 1 plain band
- If students have nose piercings, they are to either remove the piercing or wear only a clear nose stud (available for purchase from student reception)
- No other piercings are permitted at Xavier High School
- Hair must be of a natural colour
- Hair accessories (eg. ribbons) are to be neat and tidy
- Students must wear fully enclosed lace-up leather shoes or non-fabric running shoes during practical lessons and Food Technology, Technology, Art and Science Rooms
- Long hair is to be tied back at all times in practical classes
